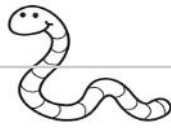

### Get to Know Your Red Wigglers Better!

- ◆ When handled roughly, they secrete a foul smelling yellow fluid
- ◆ Teenage Red Wigglers eat more than adult Red Wigglers
- ◆ They need grit in their homes (such as soil, shredded leaves and coffee grinds) to help their gizzards grind up food
