



Materials

- ♦ 2 tissue boxes
- ♦ Construction paper (white and a color of your choice)
- ♦ Scissors
- ♦ Glue
- ♦ Pen or pencil

Instructions

Trace each side of both tissue boxes onto construction paper (color of your choice) and cut out. Cut an 'X' into the two top pieces which will cover the hole in the tissue box (this is where your feet will go!). Glue each cut out piece to the corresponding sides of the box. Cut 6 white triangles from the white construction paper and glue to the top short edge of the monster feet to make claws (3 triangles per foot).

Once the glue is nice and dry, slip your feet into the boxes! You're finished!
