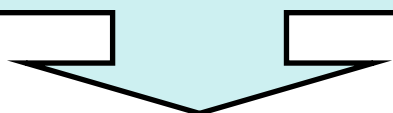

Before you run free and enjoy your summer, remember to recycle all your old school supplies.

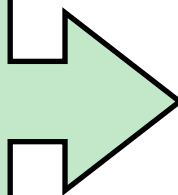


When you go grab a slushie or cold drink from Timmies, Try to refuse plastic straws because they cannot be recycled and end up in the landfill.
