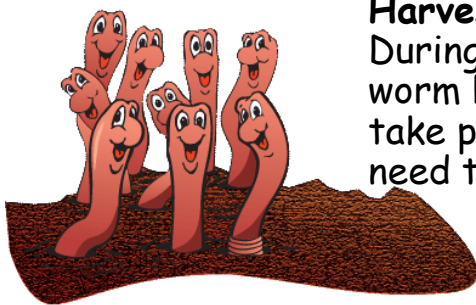
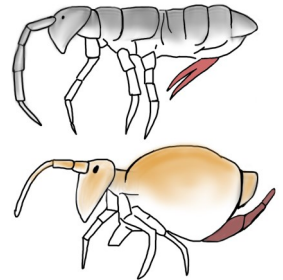


Worm Observations

During this presentation students will learn more about the biology of their worms and through observation, see how their worms react to stimuli.

Creatures of the Worm Bin

During this presentation students will learn about and get to look for the other organisms that are living in their worm bin. They will learn which of these organisms are pests, which organisms are the worms' friends, and which organisms are a combination of both!



Harvesting

During this presentation students will sort through their worm bins and separate their worms from the castings. To take part in this activity, most of the paper in the bin will need to have been eaten, so please check with the worm lady before booking to ensure your worm bin is ready!
