Office Recycling Tips for the New Year!

The beginning of the year is always a great time for discarding old habits and establishing new, healthier ones. Cultivating a holistic **eco-friendly lifestyle** can be both simple and rewarding. Recyclables only: Make sure all your collectables can be processed. Read up on the **recycling rules** for your area and follow those guidelines as best you can.

Buy Recycled: By purchasing office furniture and products manufactured from recycled materials, you'll be supporting a cyclical system of waste reduction.

Recycle Your Electronics: BBK Bottle Depot will take computer parts and other electronics, telephones, heaters, TVs etc.

Know your local recycling depots: Partnering with a local recycling company is a simple way of ensuring that your recyclables are picked up on a weekly basis. There are various local recycling companies who'll collect your office recyclables on a weekly basis for a small fee.
