## Paper Mache Penguin

You will need:
Balloon
Newspaper
Papier Mache paste
Cardboard
White glue
Sand
Funnel
Acrylic paint
Paint brush
Scissors
Masking tape
Googly eyes

Cotton



## Instructions

Use a balloon to make a paper mache Penguin, the paper mache will dry within 2 to 3 days.

- 2. When the paper mache has completely dried, pop the balloon and widen the hole on the paper mache a little bit, just large enough for a funnel to get through (approximately  $\frac{1}{2}$  to 1 inch diameter). Remove the balloon latex as well.
- 3. Insert a funnel through the hole and pour  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of sand into the paper mache.
- 4. The sand will allow the paper mache to balance and stand on its own. If it's still a bit wobbly, add a bit more sand until it is balanced.
- 5. Draw and cut out a pair of wings and feet out of cardboard.
- 6. Tape the wings and feet to the paper mache body with masking tape.
- 7. Paper mache over the hole on top as well as over the areas with masking tape. Allow the paper mache to dry.
- 8. Once dry, paint over the whole sculpture with acrylic paint.
- 9. Glue on any of these materials for the eyes and mouth

EYES - googly eyes, buttons, flat beads or round paper cut-outs MOUTH- paint or paper cut-out
