The Prince George Farmer's Market opens every Saturday from 8:30-2:00pm in parking lot at Pine Centre Mall from May until October.



There is also an indoor Farmer's Market where local goodies are available all year round! They are open Saturdays from 8:30 -2:00pm 1074 6th Avenue, right behind the Keg restaurant.

Vendors are required to sell products that they have grown, baked, or made themselves. This includes products such as local vegetables, meats, baked goods, honey, coffee, hot food, fruit, jams and jellies, and a variety of artisan crafts such as jewelry and knits.
