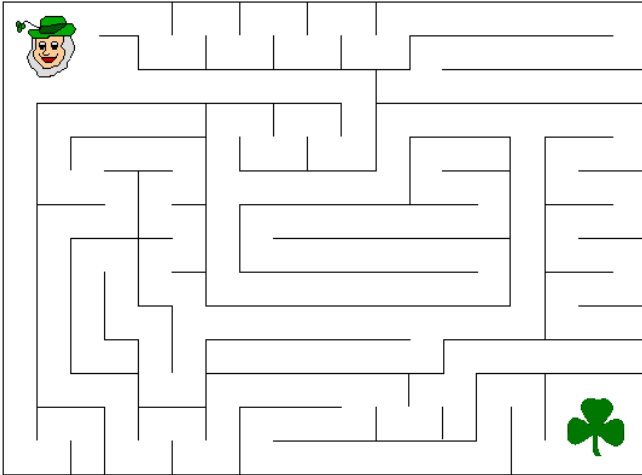

Water Conservation Tips

Make sure your taps do not drip. 15 drips a minute can add up to 2 gallons of water wasted in a day.



Keep a pitcher of water in the fridge so that you don't have to run the tap to cool it.

Turn off the tap while brushing your teeth.



Use a broom to sweep your driveway, garage or sidewalk instead of the hose.



Water your lawn and garden in the early morning or evening to avoid evaporation.



Make sure to only water the lawn and not the sidewalk or the street.

Do not pour old oil down storm drains.



Don't run the hose while washing your car, use a bucket of water and a quick hose rinse.



Run only full loads in the washer and dishwasher.



Did You KNOW???

A rainbow is sunlight spread out into an arc of colours, seen by your eyes when the sun shines through water droplets.



Manufacturing recycled paper produces 74% less air pollution and 35% less water pollution, which makes seeing the rainbows a whole lot easier. It also uses 58% less water and 64% less energy than making paper from virgin wood pulp.
